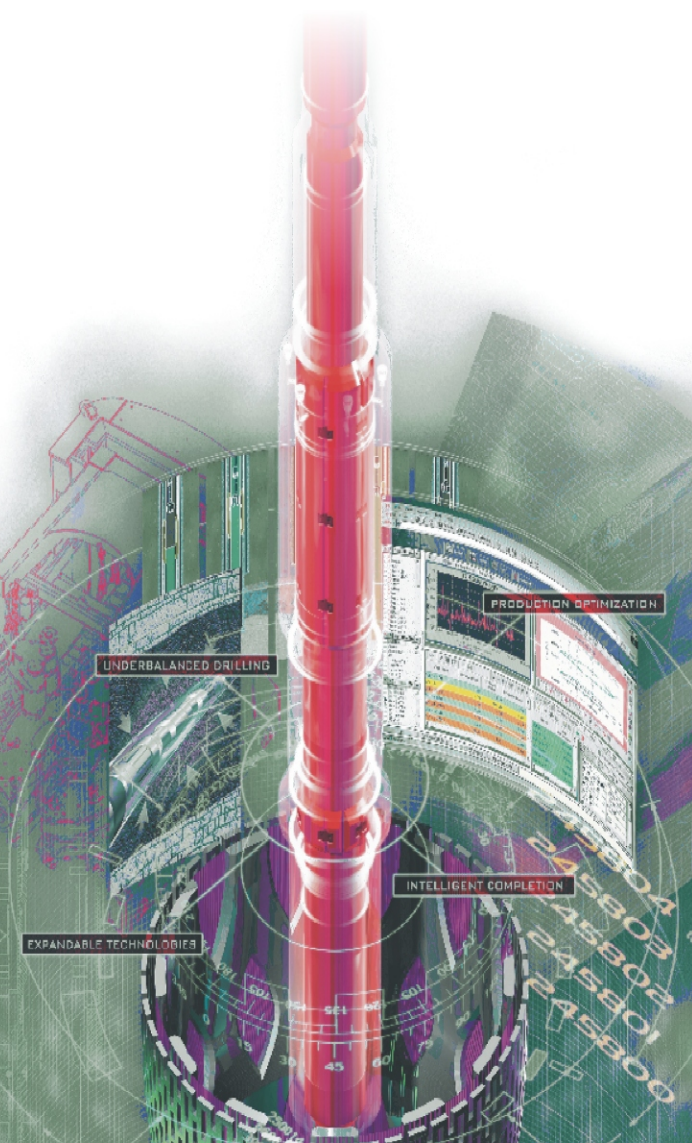

Planning

We believe that planning is a major factor in a successful re-entry project. A drill-the-well-on-paper (DWOP) exercise is part of our planning process.

Execution

Evaluation

A post-well analysis will consist of a detailed completion report for all services, including a Lessons Learned document, which will assist in the planning of future wells.
