QuickCut™ Casing Exit System with MultiCatch™ Anchor Mills Window Inside V-150 High-Yield Casing in Single Trip for Pemex in Mexico

Objectives

- Mill a window through high-yield V-150 ksi casing in minimal trips while limiting gauge loss in an onshore re-entry well.

Results

- Weatherford's *QuickCut* casing exit system with *MultiCatch* anchor was used to successfully open the window and rathole in one trip and overcame the risks associated with slips biting into the V-150 casing.
- The bottomhole milling assembly experienced just 1/16-in. of gauge loss during the operation.

Value to Client

- Weatherford's *QuickCut* system overcame the risks associated with the job and saved Pemex Comalcalco rig time and the expense of additional milling trips to complete the window.



Weatherford's *QuickCut* casing exit system is designed to create casing exits with maximum efficiency, thereby reducing the time and associated cost of drilling out from the main wellbore. Quickly and easily made up on the rig floor, it can mill a long window and deep rathole in a single trip, which can save a day or more of rig time compared to more conventional systems.
