Re-Entry Services Team Expedites Large-Bore, Dual-String Casing Exit in Remote Location and Saves Client One Day of Rig Time

Objectives

- Provide a large-bore casing-exit system and ancillary equipment at a remote location where equipment delivery is typically lengthy and challenging.
- Perform a dual casing-string exit through 13 3/8- and 18 5/8-in. casing. Because the casing strings had been cemented, cutting and pulling the tubulars was not a viable option.

Results

- The Weatherford re-entry team immediately mobilized the personnel and equipment required for the operation. The availability of the equipment in country expedited the delivery.
- The team deployed the dual-string solution, which consisted of a QuickCut[™] 3° whipstock with a hydraulically actuated MultiCatch[™] anchor and a 12.25-in. QuickCut milling assembly.
- The team ran the system to the target setting depth, oriented and set the anchor, and milled through the 13 3/8- and 18 5/8-in. tubulars in a single run.
- The entire operation in which the team milled from 5,174 to 5,205 ft (1,577 to 1,586.5 m) lasted 11.5 hours.

Value to Client

- Re-entry services provided efficient delivery, met production schedules, and reduced installation time by one day, which saved the client more than an estimated US \$500,000.
- The exemplary execution of the dual-string casing-exit solution enabled the operator to return to drilling operations and to avoid skidding the rig and redrilling the well.
