The trailer supports all sizes of COROD continuous rod and is a reliable solution for shipping continuous rod strings from a Weatherford warehouse base to the client's wellsite. The COROD deployment

trailer is equipped with a hydraulic power system that operates the hydraulic rotating hub, transfer unit, and rod straightener for running COROD continuous rod from the small transport reel into the well without human intervention. All Weatherford transport trailers are constructed with safety as the top priority. Rod-handling safety devices, such as locking tools for load securement and the brake system for control of the hub speed, are incorporated into the trailer design to reduce pinch points and the potential for injury.
